

### Faculty Introduction:

Studying the second year of the Travel and Tourism course, students use their improved skills in ICT, literacy, numeracy, team work, creative thinking, self management, reflective learning and effective participation to complete a variety of longer tasks. Guidance and support is still available, but students are encouraged to work more independently, researching different aspects of Travel and Tourism in depth.



### Topics/Modules to be covered in the year:

Students continue to follow the Edexcel Level 1 BTEC in the Introduction to Travel and Tourism syllabus and they are increasingly challenged to gain a Diploma qualification. Students study a variety of topics in Year 11 including:

Unit 7 – Recommending Holidays to Suit Customer Needs

Unit 13 – Planning for and Taking Part in a Visit

Unit 15 Preparing for Employment in Travel and Tourism

### Assessment:

Informal assessment takes place continually throughout lessons and can be verbal or written. Formal assessment of the Edexcel Level 1 Travel and Tourism is also completed by the class teachers and students are regularly informed of their academic progress. These results are also used as the working grades which are reported to parents on a termly basis.
